Drinking wine in a hurry is frustrating. Whip out a bottle, rummage for the corkscrew, **30 seconds** later you have a satisfying gulp of wine – however here lingers a bitter remorse that with a little patience the wine should have tasted much better.

Step forward **WineWeaver**. Neon spotted this good-looking gadget at **Fenwick** and after stringent and extensive tests we can conclude that it brilliantly performs the task of **wine aeration**. It works by pouring wine through perforations that WEAVE air into the wine.

Wine buffs will tell you that a wine should be poured into the curve of a glass for the best results and the **WineWeaver** does exactly so. Due to the gadget's design the wine cascades down the inner wall of the glass so not only does the aeration process begin as the wine is poured through it but **the process continues** once the wine has left it by incorporating the shape and size of the curve.

It costs **£21** (inc postage), is adjustable to fit most shapes and sizes of wineglass or decanter and it comes in **red, blue, green and purple** – we bought green to match our office glassware and it looks rather lovely on the shelf.

It is made from Polycarbon so you can chuck it in the dishwasher and is also small enough to fit into a handbag (for use in emergency).
